has always been greatly interested in music and has had the advantage of good teachers in the cultivation of his voice. He is a member of the Psi Upsilon, Composers', and the Church Clubs.

Joshua Bispham, son of Joseph and Hannah Bispham of Bickerstaffe, Lancashire, was born there the 11th of April 1706, and married Mary Lawrence the 29th of February 1729. Intending to join his brother Benjamin he sailed from London the 13th of December, 1736, in the ship "Mary and Hannah" Captain Henry Lavage, bringing with him his wife. During the voyage, on the 22d of March 1737 a daughter was born, whom they named Atlantica. They landed at Philadelphia the 26th of April 1737, after a voyage of nearly five months (1).

Joshua settled at first in Philadelphia, purchasing a house on Fifth Street, and remained there several years, probably till the death of his first wife. In 1743 he married for his second wife Ruth, daughter of Samuel and Ruth Atkinson, and granddaughter of Mahlon Stacy, her mother Ruth Atkinson being his youngest daughter. (Mahlon Stacy was descended from a Norman officer, Stacy de Bellefield who came into England at the time of the Norman Conquest with William the Conqueror, and to whom William gave valuable lands, which have continued in the Stacy family of Eng-

land to this day.) Soon after his second marriage Joshua Bispham moved to Moorestown, New Jersey, wishing to be near his brother Benjamin (who in his Will, dated 7th February 1753 appointed him his Executor).

He was Town Clerk and one of the assessors of the Township during the years 1744-45-46 and 47 and Chosen Freeholder in 1753 as appears in the first Minute Book of Chester Township, Burlington Co. There he lived and died, and some of his descendants remain in Moorestown at the present He was very much respected and loved by day. all classes of the people, his inferiors as well as his equals. A just man, and loving husband and father. He left a large amount of property, the greater part of which, in accordance with the English custom, was inherited by his eldest son, Joshua, born 27th July 1751. His other children by his second marriage were Sarah, Samuel, Benjamin, and Joseph.

Joseph Bispham the son of Joshua and Ruth Atkinson Bispham was born at Moorestown, New Jersey on the 4th of October 1759. He lived in Moorestown till his elder brother Samuel removed to Philadelphia where he joined him, probably when about twelve or thirteen years old. He was married on the 1st of April 1783 to Susanna daughter of William and Ann Pearson of Philadelphia. They

had six children, four daughters, and two sons. In 1798 he and his family left Philadelphia on account of the yellow fever which was raging there, and returned to Moorestown, where he became a farmer.

In 1831 his wife died, and he died in 1832, while on a visit at the house of his daughter Susan (Mrs. Sallows Dunlap) in Philadelphia. Like his father, Mr. Bispham was a member of the Society of Friends.

Joseph Bispham son of Joseph and Susanna Pearson Bispham, and grandson of Joshua and Ruth Atkinson Bispham, was born at Moorestown, New Jersey the 14th of January 1792. He removed with his parents to Philadelphia when he was a lad, and became a clerk in the countinghouse of Messrs. Lippincott & Richards, Auctioneers. Continuing in this business he afterwards formed a partnership with Mr. Benjamin W. Richards under the firm name of Richards and Bispham, and remained in it till his death, which occurred in 1852.

At the age of thirty-five he married Susan Ridgway Tucker, who died in 1845. He had four children three sons and a daughter. Mr. Bispham resided in Philadelphia all the remaining years of his life. His business was that of an auctioneer in bulk, his firm being the principal, if not the only one in
