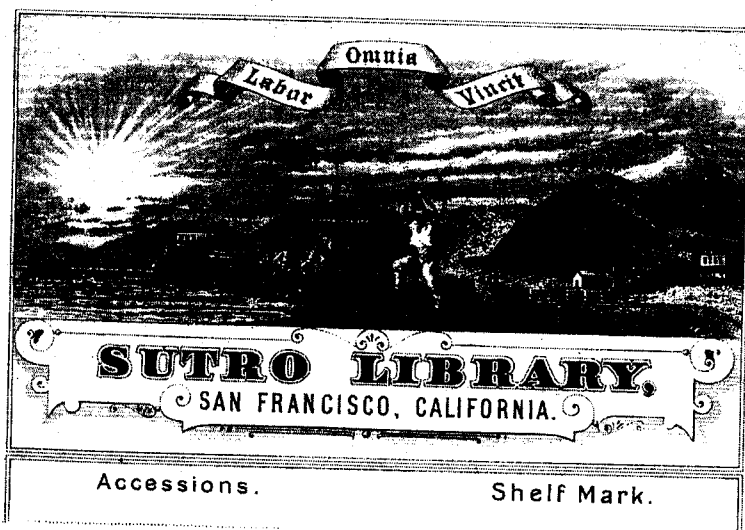

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PREFACE

Abstracts of the marriage certificates from the Concord Monthly Meeting Records are published by permission of the Concord Monthly Meeting of the Society of Friends in Delaware County, Pennsylvania obtained from Lyman W. Riley, Clerk of the Records Committee of the Philadelphia Yearly Meeting.

Concord Monthly Meeting is currently an active monthly meeting at Concordville, Pennsylvania, on U.S. Highway 1 west of Philadelphia. The Meeting was established in 1684 by Chester Quarterly Meeting. In its earliest days the Monthly Meeting was known as Chichester, then as Chichester and Concord, and finally as Concord Monthly Meeting in 1729. A Meeting House had been built at Chichester in 1688 and at Concord by 1695. [See Albert Cook Myers, Immigration of Irish Quakers into Pennsylvania, 1682-1750, (Swarthmore, PA, 1902), pp. 116-118.]

Chester County was an original county formed in the province of Pennsylvania in 1682. Delaware County was then formed from Chester in 1789. New Castle County on Delaware was a part of Pennsylvania until 1776 when Delaware declared itself independent. All of these locations are mentioned in these records. There is an index of geographical locations at the back of this book.

The original Minutes and Records of the Concord Monthly Meeting are available at Friends Historical Library of Swarthmore College, 500 College Avenue, Swarthmore, PA 198081-1399. The microfilm can be used at the Library, but cannot be borrowed. The staff will make copies of individual records for a fee. This book of abstracts of the marriage certificates was made from the microfilm copies #0020388 and #0020457 that are available for loan at the branches of the Family History Library of Salt Lake City, Utah. Film #0020388 contains the original Men's minutes including births and marriages from 1673 to 1808. Film #0020457 is a modern handwritten transcription of the original record and includes marriages from 1698 to 1907. The microfilm is listed in the microfiche "Title" catalog under "Society of Friends" and then alphabetical by the name of each meeting.
