## PELTON, NEW JERSEY

Corrections for the Pelton Family in America, 1892 Page 542: Benjamin<sup>3</sup> Pelton, born 3 Sept. 1698 in Bri tol, R.I., d. testate in Hopewell, Hunterdon Co., N. in Nov. 1775, and his widow Keziah Pelton d. there are testate in Dec. 1780, as see the N.J. Archives 34:383. The Records of the First Church, Huntington, L.I., put 1899, show Keziah Pelton admitted to membership 29 Jun 1738; and Benjamin Pelton admitted 29 Sept. 1742; as also the baptisms of their seven children, viz.: Phili Pelton on 1 Nov. 1724; Ananias Pelton on 18 June 1727; Kezia Pelton on 19 Oct. 1729; Mary Pelton on 1 July 1733; Samuel Pelton on 13 Mar. 1736/7; Elizabeth Pelto on 4 Jan. 1740/1; and John Pelton on 29 May 1743. Page 543: Keziah Felton, bapt. 19 Oct. 1729 in Hunting ton, L.I., d. after 1777 in Oxford Twp., Sussex Co N.J., wife of Joshua Smith who d. there testate in Aug 1784, see <u>N.J. Archives</u> 35:361. [The Pelton book errs in making Keziah Pelton wife of Platt Smith.] Joshua was bapt. 22 June 1714, youngest of the six sons of Jasper Smith of Maidenhead, Hunterdon Co., N.J., whold there testate in Mar. 1770 (N.J. Archives 33:394). Elizabeth Pelton, bapt. 4 Jan. 1740/1 in Huntington L I., married Charles Saxton, of Amwell Twp., Hunterdon Co., N.J., with a N.J. license dated 24 Apr. 1775. -Lewis D.
