## FOREWORD

This Lott Book grows out of work done by Dr. Robert Furman in preparation for a book on the Phillips Family of New Jersey. It was found that the names Phillips and Lott came together in so many places that it seemed desirable to know more about the Lott Family in order better to understand their various relationships with the Phillips Family. An early instance of this combining Lott and Phillips is found on page 188 of "Cooley" where it is assumed that William Phillips born 1702 was son of Joseph married twice, one wife being a Miss Lott.


We had to abolish this Joseph, as it required too great a stretch of imagination to believe that there were two separate Phillips families as shown by "Cooley" as follows:

And we found that by all the evidence William Phillips born 1702 is the son of Theophilus born 1673; and also that Miss Lott fits in perfectly as the wife (not the mother) of William Phillips born 1702. This also explains the introduction of the Lot, Lott name into the Phillips family.


