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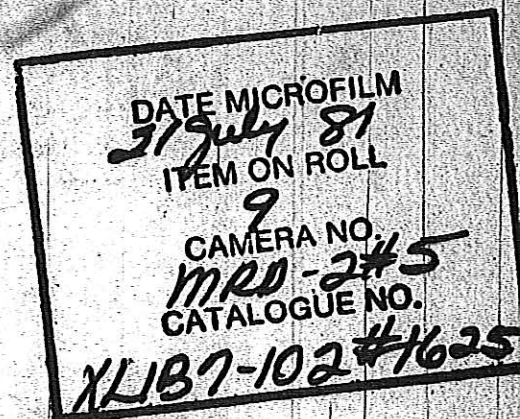

For my own satisfaction and for the benefit of all members of the Satterthwaite family now living and yet unborn, I have labored to collect all the genealogy that can readily be obtained in relation to said family, from the dissolution of the monasteries in the north of Cheshire, England, in 1537, to the present time.

Although this is intended as a record of the Satterthwaite family, I would not lightly pass the fact that our early mothers in America, as well as in England, have added much worth to the name. And while we as a family, since the coming to America, have principally been husbandmen and have nothing in the way of worldly goods of which to boast, we have endeavored to be a law-abiding, honest and industrious people, trusting in the Lord and seeking to be guided by His all-wise counsel, as revealed unto us by and through the spirit of Christ within us.

AMOS SATTERTHWAITE.

The original design of this work was to preserve in manuscript form a record of the family for the benefit of any who might wish to gain information therefrom.

Knowing this record must soon be lost if some one did not collect and preserve it, we therefore have made the effort, and in a measure have succeeded.

This work has been wholly a labor of love; and, although incomplete, its publication being desired by many of the family, we have consented.

EXPLANATIONS.

The arrangement is by generations, and the names of children in one generation, if married and they have children, are carried forward as parents in the next generation, where they may be readily found by their corresponding numbers. Except that Pleasant Worstall, daughter of James and Esther SATTERTHWAITE Worstall, born 1.1.1760, was thought to have died unmarried, until the other record was in readiness for publication, therefore it appears in families commencing on page 118.

Dates are given in the order of month, day and year, in numbers.

Abbreviations: b. for born; d. for died; dau. for daughter; m. for

married; unm. for unmarried; Res. for Residence; T. for Township; Co. for County; C. for children.

Absence of numbers in some records was occasioned by the information coming in after the manuscript was prepared for publication.

EARLY HISTORY.

Some time during the ninth or tenth century there came over the Fells or mountain ranges in the north of England a wild sea-rover, who with his companions, tall fellows with floating yellow hair and skins brown from the sea, cut themselves a road through the valley at the lake (now known as Esthwaite water), cleared a broad thwaite at the foot of the Fells, and there built a long, rambling tenement of timber, and a great hall of the same make, with dab and wattle. Then he christened Haukr-setr or Haukr-sida, or possibly, as Mr. Collingwood has suggested, Hakonar-setr, preserved, it may be, from the old place name Hawkshead, the habitation and farm of the bold Viking Haukr. Thus sprang to life our Hawkshead. Probably they came from Man, then a strong settlement of these Norsemen; and perhaps landed at Hammerside or Hilpsford on Walney, places whose names bear evidence of their fellow country men. What we must note here is, that although the home of Haukr was destined eventually to give its name to a parish thirteen miles long and six miles wide, this was but an accident, for many another Norseman took up land, settled in the same Parish, and their name can with probability be found in less important place names of the parish. It is especially necessary that we should understand what a part this Norse settlement (unrecorded in history, yet none the less certain) played in the formation of the character of the inhabitants of this district, that is, of those whose names are recorded in the Register book of the parish of Hawkshead.

The inhabitants of this hilly country were no doubt always shepherds rather than agriculturists. These people seemed to settle around the parent ancestor, making a settlement of their own name principally, yet not living by a clannish system. About the beginning of the thirteenth century we first hear of the Chapelry of Hawkshead. It appears that the Archdeacon of Richmond gave leave to the Abbot of Furness to celebrate Mass with wax candles at their private altars when the country was lying under a papal interdict, and for this purpose he assigned the chapel of Hawkshead with one bovate of land and four tofts in Dalton; in other words, the revenues of the chapel were to be applied to the purpose of the ritual. This was probably the interdict between 1198 and 1208. In 1219 and 1220 a burial ground was established at Hawkshead. After the dissolution of the Monasteries in 1537 these descendants of the Norsemen seemed

And then & there in the same assembly she the said Pleasant Mead did in like manner declare that she took him the said William Satterthwaite to be her husband promising by the Lord's assistance to be unto him a loving & faithful wife until death should separate them (or worse to the same purpose). And moreover they the said William Satterthwaite & Pleasant Mead the according to the custom of marriage assuming the name of her husband now Pleasant Satterthwaite as a further confirmation thereof & then & there to these presents set their hands. And we whose names are here under also subscribed being present at the solemnization of the said marriage & subscription as aforesaid. Have our witnesses thereto set our hands this day & year above written.

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to exhibit an unrest which lasted until the advent of George Fox, with whom many joined, and after the organization of the Society of Friends and the persecutions that followed, many of these people came to America; among the many were some of the name Satterthwaite, as the records of Friends here show. One, James Satterthwaite, was a member at Burlington, N. J., as early as 1680. Whether he was the one that had his house burned in Penns Manor, Bucks Co., Pa., in 1683, has not been proven. In 1684 there were many fines imposed in Hawkshead parish for attending Friends' meetings. William, Edward and Charles Satterthwaite, with many others, were fined ten shillings each. Friends' meeting house at Swarthmoor was built 1689, that at Colthouse 1698.

THE NAME SATTERTHWAITE.

This, the third strongest family in Hawkshead parish, evidently is of the few names that are taken from a place in the parish, and is of course of purely local origin. The meaning of the place-name is without doubt the setr or settlement in the thwaite or woodland clearing—originally Setrthwaite. This name seems to have spread less than the other great stocks, and out of eighty wills in the Archdeaconry seventy are in the parish. They were found at Satterthwaite itself, where, however, they were less strong than at other places, Sawrey, Colthouse, Parkamoore, Roger ground, etc. Colthouse was the main stronghold of the name, and the family that is still represented there have long been members of the Society of Friends. The place that our American ancestor came from, it is believed, is now occupied by one William Satterthwaite, J. P., in the parish. His daughter Elizabeth was in America on a visit in 1907. These friends entertain many American visitors to the north of England.

Of the foregoing much has been taken from the Hawkshead Register.

SATTERTHWAITE IN ENGLAND, A. D. 1532.

In 1532 (24th of Henry VIII) William Satterthwaite was a monk of Furness Abbey and Edward, John, Richard and Edward Saterthwet were tenants of the Abbey residing in "Furness Fells" (see indenture signed at Hawkshead Hall 1st November (24 of Henry VIII) given in (West's Antiquities of Furness 220).

In 1546 (37th of Henry VIII) the following Satterthwaites were tenants of property in the manor of Braysbrown in Langdale, parish of Grasmere.

See grant of the manor of Braysbrown from Henry VIII to John Benson amongst the originalia and memoranda of the exchequer.

The Register of the Society of Friends at their commencement about 1650 shows the existence of four families of Satterthwaites in Hawkshead Meeting.

Note.—There appear to have been various ways of spelling the name in the old records.

For the preceding record we are mostly indebted to James S. and Mary Holdsworth, of Bolton, who visited America in 1894, having with them a chart of the Satterthwaite family, prepared by Michael Satterthwaite, M. D., of England. James S. and Mary again visited America in 1899, she being a direct descendant of Michael and Esther Tyson Satterthwaite.

William Satterthwaite, 1st of Michael and Esther Tyson, b. 1.25. 1709, came to America with a Certificate from Swarthmoor Monthly Meeting, held at Rook-How, bearing date 12th Mo. 5th, 1733, he being in the 24th year of his age. He settled in Lower Makefield Township, Bucks County, Pa., on a farm owned by a descendant until 1852.

"The above dates previous to Sept. 3d, 1752, are Old Style, and the day following Sept. 2d was made Sept. 14th, there being at this time 11 days difference. Also at that period the month called March was styled 1st Month and began the year in England and her Colonies. Thus the birth of William Satterthwaite, 12 Mo. 22d, 1740, was in Feb. 22d, 1740, Old

Style, which would be March 5th, 1741, New Style. This agrees with an account of his age that was in his daughter's possession."

The following is taken from Minute book A of records of Friends of Middletown Monthly Meeting, page 259:

"William Satterthwaite, a young man, lately arrived here from Old England, hath produced a certificate from Swarthmoor Monthly Meeting in Lancashire recommending him as a young man of orderly conversation and in unity with Friends; with which certificate this meeting is satisfied and orders that it be kept with such of ye Meetings papers."

To Friends in Pennsylvania in America.

These lines may certify Friends that the bearer hereof William Satterthwaite, son of Michael Satterthwaite and Esther his wife, belonging unto this Monthly Meeting hath this day signified unto us that for some time he hath inclined to remove himself into your Province, to reside their amongst you. This may also certify all to whom it may come, that his removal is with the allowance and approbation of his Parents, with whom he had a sober education and hath been since the time of his minority of a sober and orderly life and conversation, and is clear from all women in these parts on account of Marriage, as far as we know, and also clear from the contracting of any debts, being an able and industrious workman in the tilling of ground or husbandry, according to the way and manner of this Country. We do recommend him as a person in union and fellowship with us, to your care, sincerely desiring he may be preserved in the way of piety and virtue and, that your regard may be unto him for his good in all respects. So with sincere love we conclude and remain your Friends and Brethern.
