WILLIAM ELY, second yen of John and Frances (Venables) Ely, born at Trenton about 1709, and married March 25, 1734, JEMIMA HUNT. He inherited from his father one-half of the plantation settled by his grandfather Joshua Ely in 1685, and was living thereon in 1737, but prior to his death in 1770, he conveyed it to BENJAMIN BILES, of whom he purchased in 1754 two tracts of land in Trenton, a large part of which was built upomore or less during his lifetime. The William Ely is dated November 10, 1763 and proved April 19, 1770. His widow survived him several

years. CHILDREN: 61. John Ely, born 1735; died at Trenton Sept. \*/ 1767; merried SARAH (MULLEN) BILES, widow of THOMAS BILES, and daughter of John Mullen. \*(His Will 25 July 1767-19 Sept. 1767, in <u>N.J.
