The Whitehall coat of arms from the 1664 Visitation of Staffordshire

[Harleian MSS Vol, Book 6106 p. 59/British Museum] gives an ancestry back to

Robert [S/o William Whitehall (in 1500's at times as Whitehaugh)] of the 5th yr of reign of Henry I (= 1413).
