My great grandmother Sidney Repplier was married twice, both times as a Roman Catholic at St. Patrick's Cathedral in Harrisburg. This inquiry is about her two families.

Second, by any chance are any of the following five persons buried at Mount Calvery?

John George Haggerty (Sidney's first husband, resided Harrisburg) b. about 1842

d. about October 1874 Harrisburg (his estate was inventoried Nov. 1 1874)

Mary Theresa Haggerty (child of John George and Sidney Haggerty; baptized St. Patrick's)

b. 19 Oct 1870

d. infancy or young

Catharine Repplier Haggerty (child of John George and Sidney Haggerty; baptized St. Patrick's)

b. 14 Oct 1872

d. infancy or young

John Haggerty (child of John George and Sidney Haggerty; baptized St. Patrick's)

b. 19 Dec 1874

d. infancy or young

Jacob Lancaster Repplier (Sidney's second husband, resided Harrisburg & Reading)

b. 15 May 1844

d. 21 Apr 1901 Reading, Pa.

buried "Hamburg (Harrisburg)" per the Reading Dept. of Public Safety ledger

I cannot make sense of the "Hamburg (Harrisburg)", as I cannot find a Hamburg Cemetery in Harrisburg, nor a Catholic cemetery in Hamburg, Berks County.
