Will of John Wadleigh senior of Wells in County of York

I make my son Robert Wadleigh my sole heir
of and unto all my houses and lands in new England

I bequest and freely give unto my daughter Mary Mills
a pair of oxen named Sparke and Berey
which are in the hands of

I desire my body may be decently buried... the
place of my burial to be by my wife her grave who
is now deceased.
