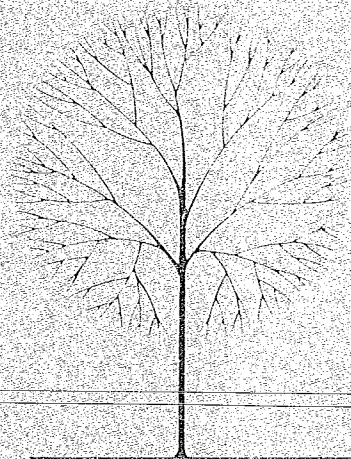

Contercock No. 6. Was granted by the Masonian pro-  
 prieters to James Wallace, Robert Wallace, John McMurphy, Andrew  
 Goble and others of Londonderry, July 16, 1752. It was incorporated  
 Nov 10, 1768, by the name of Kinnickinnick. The first settlement was made  
 1761, by James Allen, followed the next year by Eliakim Howe,  
 James Gould, Thomas Stone, in June, and Jonas Bowman in  
 September. The first child born in town was Persis, Dr. Eliakim  
 Howe, (date not known) who in a wheeler and settled in Hillsborough.

The congregational church was organized Jan 7, 1769, when  
 there were 30 families in the town. The heads of these families were
